BC SOCCER ACADEMIES ASSOCIATION

Incorporated under the Societies Act (British Columbia)

Incorporation No. S0067747 | Incorporated July 6, 2017

PART 1 - NAME

- 1.1 The name of the Society is BC Soccer Academies Association (the "Association" or "BCSAA").

PART 2 - PURPOSES

- 2.1 The purposes of the Association are:

- (a) to develop, promote, support, govern, and administer youth soccer for boys and girls in British Columbia, with a particular focus on soccer academies and academy-based programming;
- (b) to unite and support soccer academies operating in British Columbia and to provide a forum for cooperation, coordination, and the advancement of common standards among them;
- (c) to establish, operate, govern, and administer youth soccer leagues, competitions, events, and related programs, including the Academy Super League (ASL);
- (d) to support the development of players, coaches, referees, administrators, and other participants through education, training, competition, and opportunities that foster physical, mental, social, ethical, and leadership development;
- (e) to establish and maintain rules, regulations, policies, codes of conduct, safety standards, discipline processes, and appeal processes for programs and competitions operated by the Association;
- (f) to promote safe, respectful, inclusive, accessible, and fair participation in youth soccer and to support the protection and well-being of children and youth participating in the Association's activities;
- (g) to secure, coordinate, and support access to fields, facilities, equipment, insurance, officials, and other resources needed to deliver the Association's programs and competitions;
- (h) to represent the interests of the Association and its members in dealings with governments, facility operators, community organizations, service providers, and other persons or organizations whose activities affect the Association's purposes; and

- (i) to carry out activities ancillary and incidental to the attainment of the foregoing purposes.

PART 3 - UNALTERABLE PROVISION: WINDING UP

3.1 Upon winding up or dissolution of the Association, after payment of all costs, charges, and expenses properly incurred in the winding up, the remaining assets of the Association shall be distributed to:

- (a) a registered charity or registered charities in British Columbia, as defined by the Income Tax Act (Canada), as determined by the members of the Association at the time of winding up or dissolution; or
- (b) such charitable organization or organizations in British Columbia having similar charitable purposes as the Association.

3.2 This provision is unalterable.
